PER CURIAM:

Hettie L. Dula appeals the district court's orders dismissing her actions filed under the Americans with Disabilities Act, 42 U.S.C.A. §§ 12101-12213 (West 1994 & Supp. 1999), and denying her motions to reconsider. We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinions and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the district court. See Dula v. Ford Motor Co., Nos.
