PER CURIAM:

Thomas E. Bowman appeals the district court's orders denying relief on his 42 U.S.C.A. § 1983 (West Supp. 1999) complaint and denying his motion for reconsideration. We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinions and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the district court. See Bowman v. Walker, No. CA-98-506-R (W.D.
