PER CURIAM:

James H. Fitzgerald, Sr., a Virginia inmate, appeals the district court's order denying relief on his 42 U.S.C.A. § 1983 (West Supp. 1999) complaint under 28 U.S.C.A. § 1915A(b)(1) (West Supp. 1999). We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm the appeal on the reasoning of the district court. See Fitzgerald v. Frye, No. CA-98-598-AM (E.D. Va. Mar. 1, 1999).
