PER CURIAM:

Charles Richard Flint appeals the district court's order denying relief on his petition filed under 28 U.S.C.A. § 2254 (West 1994 & Supp. 1999). We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion adopting the report and recommendation of the magistrate judge and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the district court. See Flint v. Painter, No. CA-98-691-5 (S.D.W. Va. Sept. 29, 1999).
