

## How to Set Your Computer to Play Oral Argument Audio Files

If you attempt to listen to the oral argument audio files and are prompted to save the file rather than the file playing immediately, follow the steps below.

### Windows XP

1. Double click **My Computer**
2. Select **Tools**
3. Select **Folder Options**
4. Select the **File Types** tab
5. When the list populates, select **MP3**
  - a. The program listed under “Details for MP3 extension” should open the MP3 file automatically.
  - b. Select **Change** to select a different audio player
6. If MP3 is not an option:
  - a. Select **New**
  - b. Enter **MP3** in the *File Extension* box
  - c. Select **Advanced**
  - d. Select **MP3 Audio File (mp3)** from the *Associated File Type* drop down menu
  - e. Select **OK**
7. Select **OK**

### Windows 7

1. Select the **Windows** button
2. Select **Control Panel**
3. Select **Default Programs**
4. Select the **Associated a file type or protocol with a program**
5. When the list populates, select **MP3**
  - a. The program listed under “Current Default” should open the MP3 file automatically.
  - b. Select **Change Program** to select a different audio player
6. Select **Close**
