- (1) the pro se pleading entitled: "NO SEAL ON UNITED SATAN REDACTION" is construed as a motion to unseal the Government's proposed redactions of Mr. Moussaoui's pleadings. The Court denies the motion;

- (2) the pro se pleading entitled: "HIGH-TECH LYNCH IN PROGRESS" is construed as a motion for a transcript of the open and sealed oral arguments conducted on June 3. The Court grants the motion in part and directs that Mr. Moussaoui be provided with a CD recording of the open hearing and a redacted transcript of the sealed hearing, if these items have not already been provided to him.
