ORDER

The pro se pleadings filed Mr. Moussaoui are treated as follows:

- (1) the pro se pleading entitled: "FREEDOM OF INFORMATION" is construed as a motion to be provided with unredacted copies of orders and transcripts from the district court. The Court denies the motion;

- (2) the pro se pleading entitled: "ASHCROFT POLITICAL SENSURE OF THE TRUTH" is construed as a motion to reconsider the redactions of Mr. Moussaoui's pleading of March 28, 2003. The Court denies the motion;
- (3) the pro se pleading entitled: "NO MORE GAME ..." is construed as a second pro se supplemental brief;
- (4) the pro se pleading entitled: "9/11 MASTERMIND MUST BE HEARD" is construed as a petition for writ of mandamus. The Court denies the petition;
- (5) the pro se pleading entitled: "MOHAMMED ALIBI TESTIMONY" is construed as a third pro se supplemental brief;
- (6) the pro se pleading entitled: "5TH PLANE MUST LAND ON MOUSSAOUI RUNWAY" is construed as a motion for an unredacted copy of the government's brief. The Court denies the motion;
- (7) the pro se pleading entitled: "LIEONIE MUST GIVE DUE CONSIDERATION" is construed as an appeal from the district court's order of April 21, 2003. The appeal has been docketed as case No. 03-4399.
