PER CURIAM:

Tony Lovette appeals the district court's order granting summary judgment in favor of his former employer, Sonoco Products Company, in his civil action alleging employment discrimination and wrongful termination. We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and find no reversible error.
