PER CURIAM:

Linda L. King appeals from the district court's orders dismissing her appeal from the bankruptcy court's order for failure to comply with Fed. R. Bankr. P. 8009(a), and denying her motion for reconsideration. We have reviewed the record and the district court's orders and find no reversible error and no abuse of discretion. See Fed. R. Bankr.
