PER CURIAM:

Linda Ann Tyler appeals the district court's order denying relief on his 42 U.S.C.A. § 1983 (West Supp. 2000) complaint. We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion accepting the magistrate judge's recommendation and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the district court. See Tyler v. Rackley, No. CA-99-2845-4-24-BF (D.S.C. Mar. 30, 2001).
