PER CURIAM:

Wayne Johnson appeals the district court's order denying relief on his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2000) complaint, which the court properly construed as an action under Bivens v. Six Unknown Named Agents of Fed. Bureau of Narcotics, 403 U.S. 388 (1971). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the district court. See Johnson v. Flannery, No. CA-02-294-3 (E.D. Va. Oct. 18, 2002).
