PER CURIAM:

Mohammad Alghanem and Manal Abokwidir, husband and wife, appeal from the district court's order affirming the bankruptcy court's order setting aside the transfer of Alghanem's property, from Alghanem to himself and his wife, as a fraudulent conveyance under 11 U.S.C. § 548(a)(1) (2000). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. See King v. Alghanem, No. CA-03-1112-A (E.D. Va. Jan. 12, 2004). We dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before the court and argument would not aid the decisional process.
