PER CURIAM:

Hassan Shabazz and Tyrone L. Johnson appeal the district court's order denying relief on their 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2000) complaint. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the district court. See Shabazz v. Braxton, No. CA-03-39-7 (W.D. Va. Sept. 8, 2004). We grant Shabazz's motion to amend his informal brief filed in this court.
