PER CURIAM:

Harry Richard Hammar, III, appeals from the district court's order denying relief on his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2000) complaint under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2) (2000). We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion, and we find that Hammar failed to state a claim for which relief may be granted. See Estelle v. Gamble, 429 U.S. 97 (1976). Accordingly, we affirm the dismissal of his complaint.
