PER CURIAM:

Jose Francisco Noesi appeals the district court's order dismissing his Bivens v. Unknown Named Agents of Federal Bureau of Narcotics, 403 U.S. 388 (1971) complaint as frivolous under 28 U.S.C. § 1915A (2000). We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error.
