PER CURIAM:

Marion Leon Bea appeals the district court's order denying relief on his motions to file an amended complaint in a 42 U.S.C. § 1983 (2000) action that was already closed, which the district court construed as motions for reconsideration of the dismissal of the § 1983 complaint.
