PER CURIAM:

Demetrius Renee Walker appeals the district court's orders denying her 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) (2006) motion for a sentence reduction and for reconsideration. We have reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm for the reasons stated by the district court. United States v. Walker, No. 3:05-cr-00759-JFA-22 (D.S.C. Nov. 19, 2008; Jan. 8, 2009).
