PER CURIAM:

James Jones, Jr., appeals the district court's order accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and granting summary judgment in favor of G.E. Gas Turbines LLC on Jones' discrimination and retaliation claims under Title VII of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended 42 U.S.C. §§ 2000e to 2000e-17 (2006 & Supp. IV 2010), and 42 U.S.C. § 1981 (2006). We have thoroughly reviewed the record and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm.
