PER CURIAM:

Appellant appeals from the district court's order granting summary judgment to the Appellee in this action alleging employment discrimination. We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the district court. Smith v. South Carolina Budget & Control, No. CA-93-1453-3-OBC (D.S.C. Sept. 28, 1995).
