PER CURIAM:

Appellant appeals from the Benefits Review Board's final decision and order denying his claim for benefits under the Black Lung Benefits Act, 30 U.S.C.A. §§ 901-945 (West 1986 & Supp. 1996). We have reviewed the record and the Benefits Review Board's order affirming the decision of the administrative law judge and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the Benefits Review Board. Taylor v. Director, Office of Workers' Compensation Programs, No. 95-1985-BLA (B.R.B. Jan. 18, 1996).
