PER CURIAM:

Brenda Faye Wray appeals the district court's order affirming the bankruptcy court's order which (1) confirmed the debtor's proposed Chapter 13 plan and (2) imposed sanctions against her attorney. Our review of the record and the district court's opinion discloses no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the district court. Wray v. Harrison, No. CA-97-353-3 (E.D. Va. Aug. 21, 1997). We dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before the court and argument would not aid the decisional process.*
