PER CURIAM:

Petitioner filed a mandamus petition alleging delay in the district court in ruling on his motion for reduction of sentence. The district court has since denied the motion. United States v. Legree, No. CR-93-92 (D.S.C. Sept. 30, 1997). Accordingly, although we grant Petitioner's motion to proceed in forma pauperis, we deny the mandamus petition as moot.
