PER CURIAM:

Anthony Jerome Wilson seeks to appeal the district court's order denying relief on his petition filed under 28 U.S.C.A. § 2254 (West 1994 & Supp. 1998). We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we deny a certificate of appealability and dismiss the appeal on the reasoning of the district court. Wilson v. Corcoran, No. CA-96-3140-DKC (D. Md. Sept. 10, 1997). We deny Wilson's motions for appointment of counsel and to file formal briefs, grant his motion to amend the informal brief, and dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before the court and argument would not aid the decisional process.
