PER CURIAM:

Rick Allen Yount appeals the district court's orders (1) affirming the bankruptcy court's order determining that a debt owed to him was dischargeable in bankruptcy and (2) denying his motion for reconsideration. Our review of the record and the district court's opinions discloses no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the district court. Yount v. Yount, Nos. CA-97-25-2; BK-96-20884 (N.D.W. Va. May 4 & 13, 1998).
