PER CURIAM:

Dianna Wood appeals the district court's order affirming the Commissioner of Social Security's finding that she is not disabled and therefore not entitled to disability benefits. We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the district court. See Wood v. Commissioner, No. CA-96-167-B (W.D. Va. Sept. 23, 1998). We dispense with oral argument because the facts and legal contentions are adequately presented in the materials before the court and argument would not aid the decisional process.
