PER CURIAM:

Jose Juan Garcia appeals the district court's order denying his request for a writ of mandamus pursuant to 12 U.S.C. § 1361 (1994), to compel the Immigration and Naturalization Service to commence deportation proceedings. We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinion and find no reversible error. Accordingly, we affirm on the reasoning of the district court. Garcia v. INS, No. CA-98-40-2 (E.D. Va.
