PER CURIAM:

Ephrain Reliford, Jr., seeks to appeal the district court's orders denying relief on his petition filed under 28 U.S.C.A. § 2254 (West 1994 & Supp. 1998) and denying his motion for reconsideration. We have reviewed the record and the district court's opinions accepting the recommendation of the magistrate judge and find no reversible error.
