## PER CURIAM:

Joshua Julius Cole appeals the district court's order denying his motion for a sentence reduction pursuant to the First Step Act of 2018, Pub. L. No. 115-391, § 404(b), 132 Stat. 5194, 5222. Having reviewed the record, we conclude that the district court did not abuse its discretion in denying Cole's motion. *See United States v. Jackson*, 952 F.3d 492, 497, 502 (4th Cir. 2020) (stating standard of review). Accordingly, we affirm.
