PER CURIAM:

Kevin A. Baker petitions for a writ of mandamus, alleging that the district court has unduly delayed acting on his motion for a sentence reduction under Section 404 of the First Step Act of 2018, Pub. L. No. 115-391, 132 Stat. 5194. He seeks an order from this court directing the district court to act. Our review of the district court's docket reveals that the district court has granted Baker's motion. Accordingly, because the district court has recently decided Baker's case, we deny the mandamus petition as moot.
