PER CURIAM:

Casey Rafael Tyler appeals the district court's order accepting in part the recommendation of the magistrate judge and granting Defendant Pamela J. Locklear's motion for summary judgment in Tyler's 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action. Tyler also appeals the magistrate judge's text orders denying Tyler's motions to appoint counsel.
