PER CURIAM:

Percy James Tucker appeals the district court's order denying his motion for early termination of supervised release under 18 U.S.C. § 3583(e). We have reviewed the record and find no abuse of discretion. *See United States v. Pregent*, 190 F.3d 279, 282 (4th Cir. 1999) (reviewing denial of § 3583(e) motion for abuse of discretion). Accordingly, we affirm the district court's order. *See United States v. Tucker*, No. 2:09-cr-00182-AWA-DEM-1 (E.D. Va. Aug. 14, 2025).
