PER CURIAM:

Marcus Antonio Blanks appeals the district court's order denying his 18 U.S.C. § 3582(c)(2) motion for a sentence reduction pursuant to Amendment 821 to the Sentencing Guidelines. We have reviewed the record and discern no abuse of discretion in the denial of Blanks's motion. *See United States v. Spruhan*, 989 F.3d 266, 269 (4th Cir. 2021) (providing standard).
